

# Guidelines for digital file submission to Imago Imaging



## WHAT KIND OF FILES TO SUBMIT?

The table below lists file formats that work best at **Imago Imaging**. Files can be submitted in formats other than the ones mentioned below but please contact **Imago Imaging** before submitting these types of files.

<b>FILE TYPE (RASTER)</b>	TIFF, TIFF-IT, PSD, JPEG, JPEG2000, CT/LW
<b>FILE TYPE (VECTOR)</b>	PDF, EPS
<b>FILE TYPE (LAYOUT)</b>	Quark XPress 3.31 and above Adobe InDesign 1.5 and above Adobe Illustrator Adobe Pagemaker Macromedia Freehand 7.0 and above

## ICC PROFILES:

To permit the best color accurate reproduction, please include ICC profiles with raster files and artwork. If no profiles are included with files, sRGB will be assumed for RGB content and Adobe's US Web Coated SWOP v2 for CMYK content.

## LAYOUT FILES:

Before submitting layout files, please check that:

- all fonts are included with the submission
- all linked objects are included with the submission
- all placed content is at the correct resolution for final output
- all spot colors that will be converted to process for final output are converted to process before submission

## PDF CREATION:

If you are using Acrobat Distiller 5 to create your PDF files, use the Imago imaging presets available at:
